Hon'ble Speaker Sir,

With your kind permission, I rise to present the Budget Speech for the financial year 2023 – 2024 before this August House.

In the third year of the third term of this Government under the dynamic leadership of our Hon'ble Chief Minister, Mamata Banerjee, this department will try its best to live up to the expectations of the people of West Bengal. We pledge to place West Bengal in its position of eminence among all the States of the country.

I humbly place before You and the distinguished Members of the Hon'ble House that we are moving steadily towards this goal.

2. Sir, on the recommendation of The Hon'ble Governor of West Bengal, I have the pleasure to move that a sum of Rs. 7665,84,55,000/- (Rupees Seven Thousand Six Hundred Sixty Five Crore Eighty Four Lakh and Fifty Five Thousand) only, may be granted for incurring voted expenditure under Demand no. 25 for the financial year 2023-2024.

- 3. I would like to inform the Honorable Members that the Public Works Department is the key organization that creates huge social assets and transforms the physical structure into public asset and an effective means of communication by building Roads & Bridges for Public use. Virtually, all important public buildings i.e. Hospitals, Govt. Offices, Fire Stations, Heritage Structures etc. etc. are built / maintained by P.W. Department. Since coming into being, PWD has played an important role in building social infrastructure.
- 4. As PWD is one of the most important works departments, considerable budget outlay is provided to this Department for execution of works. The Department has an elaborate organizational set-up, headed by an Officer in the rank of Secretary. Apart from its secretariat, it has two engineering directorate headed by Chief Engineers and one coordinating head i.e. Engineer - in - Chief. Besides it has one dedicated Finance Wing headed by the Financial Adviser. The functional authority of different levels of officers is well defined through an elaborate coding pattern; much of its authority comes through application of codified rules. To expedite the process of work under this department, several Government Orders indicating reforms in its functional area have been issued. They, in fact, contribute to removing many impediments standing in the way of smooth functioning.

- 5. The P. W. Department is entrusted with the development and maintenance of roads, bridges and buildings that cover from difficult hilly areas of Darjeeling to the coastal areas of mangroves at the Sunderbans & around Digha. For equitable economic growth, development of physical Infrastructure is a must, and P.W.D is striving towards this goal. The P. W. Department is responsible for maintenance and up-gradation of 20,102 km different categories of roads and 2,093 bridges. Out of 20,102 km roads, 3,817 km are State Highways, 10,537 km are Major District Roads and 5,748 km are Other Roads which comprise Other District Roads and Village Roads.
- **6.** Apart from this, the NH Wing of P.W.D. maintains 1,632 km of National Highways and 384 Bridges within the State of West Bengal.
- 7. The Social Sector Wing of P.W.D ordinarily executes public works in the shape of either deposit works or Treasury Remittance (TR) works funded by different departments and other organizations/institutions.
- 8. Electrical wing in PWD is capable of providing multiple tasks of building utility services both in original and maintenance nature as per policy of the Government of West Bengal.
- This department has its own Research & Development Wing namely Road and Building Research Institute for quality checking of different types of work.
- **9.1** This Institute has two units as follows under the supervision of the Chief Engineer & Director, R&BRI:
 - a) One is at Pailanhat in the district of South 24 Parganas, and other is at
 - b) Noukaghat, Siliguri in the district of Darjeeling.

9.2 These two units are equipped with different kinds of field and laboratory equipment for collection of fieldsamples and carrying on quality-control lab-tests. Apart from that, different research works for development of better specifications of different Civil Engineering works and preparation of better & cost-effective mix-designs for concrete and bituminous works are also the aim of this Institution.

10. Policy Objectives:

Prime objectives of Public Works Department are:

- **10.1** To make durable roads by adopting latest codes and ensuring compliance with environment considerations.
- **10.2** To improve/ upgrade roads, to construct new bridges/ ROBs/Flyovers/Government Buildings and maintenance of them.
- **10.3** To augment capacity of the roads by widening & strengthening of the roads.
- **10.4** To improve road connectivity by at least 2 lane roads between
 - (a) all adjacent district headquarters, (b) within a district, from district headquarter to the Administrative sub division headquarters and (c) within a district, from one Administrative sub division headquarter to other sub division headquarter.
- **10.5** To ensure road safety by correcting the existing road geometry and by providing adequate road signage.
- 10.6 To rehabilitate/ replace old dilapidated/ weak bridges as well as to rehabilitate old Government Buildings.

11. Achievements during the period from 01/04/2022 to 15/02/2023:

11.1 Road Sector:

11.1.1 During this period PWD has widened & strengthened 490 km of road to augment the capacity (completed). The break up as follows:

- 44 km of road has been widened up to 4 lane carriageway width (i.e. 14 m carriageway width) & strengthened.
- 41 km of road has been widened up to 2 lane carriageway width with 1.50 m wide paved shoulder on either side of the road (i.e.10 m carriageway width) & strengthened.
- 232 km of road has been widened up to 2 lane carriageway width (i.e.7 m carriageway width) & strengthened.
- 144 km of road has been widened up to Intermediate lane carriageway width (i.e. 5.50 m carriageway width) & strengthened.
- 29 km of road has been widened up to Single lane carriageway width (i.e. 3.75 m carriageway width) & strengthened.

11.1.2 During the said period another 2220 km of road has been improved (completed). The Break up as follows:

- 810 km of road has been strengthened / improved.
- Surfacing work completed on 1410 km of road length.

11.2 Bridge Sector:

- PWD has inspected all 2093 bridges to take safety measure of the bridges.
- 27 bridges, 2 ROBs and 1 underpass have been newly constructed during the above period.

Rehabilitation works have been completed over 108 bridges.

11.3 Building Sector:

- 20 nos. of own departmental building works and around 550 building related works of Other Departments have been completed during the above period.
- 12. Works taken up during the period from 01/04/2022 to 15/02/2023.

12.1 Road Sector:

- 12.1.1 During this period PWD has taken up 299 km of road for widening & strengthening to augment the capacity. The break up as follows:
 - 169 km of road has been taken up for widening up to 2 lane carriageway width with 1.50 m wide paved shoulder on either side of the road (i.e. 10 m carriageway width) & strengthening.
 - 84 km of road has been taken up for widening up to 2 lane carriageway width (i.e. 7 m carriageway width) & strengthening.
 - 46 km of road has been taken up for widening up to Intermediate lane carriageway width (i.e. 5.50 m carriageway width) & strengthening.

12.1.2 During the said period another 775 km of road has been taken up for improvement. The Break up as follows:

- 466 km of road has been taken up for strengthening and improvement.
- 309 km of road has been taken up for surfacing work.

12.2 Bridge Sector:

- 7 bridges have been considered for new construction
- 75 bridges have been taken up for Rehabilitation.

- A number of Road Safety Projects in different busy roads have been taken up.

17. National Highways

- 17.1 There are 33 nos. of National Highways in the State of West Bengal with a total length of 3,574 km. The National Highways (NH) wing of this department executes the widening, improvement and maintenance works on 23 nos. of NHs with a total length of 1,632 km. At present, work is going on for 178 km of NHs.
- 17.2 Total 20 nos. of Road Over Bridge (ROB) projects under Setu-Bharatam scheme have been sanctioned for execution by PIU-ROB of NH wing. Out of those, 4 projects have already been completed, 9 projects are in progress, 2 projects will be awarded shortly and tenders will be invited for the remaining 5 projects.
- 17.3 National Highway Authority of India (NHAI) and National Highway Infrastructure Development

Corporation Limited (NHIDCL) execute the works related to widening, improvement and maintenance of 1,850 km and 92 km of National Highways respectively in the State where this department closely monitors the projects and time to time holds coordination meetings with the stakeholders and the district administrations to resolve the issues or bottlenecks in order to expedite the construction works for early completion.

18. Apart from above, the Public Works Department is also executing various roads, bridges, buildings and other projects of other departments of the State Government.
